We are 501(c)3 arts nonprofit established in 2017 and dedicated to building community and driving economic vitality through the arts.

Celebrating art in all forms, we highlight our local artist community and develop a sense of cultural identity by:

- Managing Havre de Grace's Arts & Entertainment District on behalf of the City government
- Acting as the author, steward, and commissioning agent for the Havre de Grace Public Art and Sculpture Trails
- Operating two art galleries in Havre de Grace an artist co-operative in Arts By The Bay and a metropolitan fine art gallery in Gallery 220
- Conducting art workshops for children and families, open studio sessions, and professional development seminars for creatives of all experience levels
- Hosting live performances that include jazz, big band, classical, and global music concerts; poetry slams and original book and play readings; and cultural celebrations of history, heritage, and more
- Creating cultural, history, and heritage programs that celebrate Black History Month, Women's History Month, Asian American & Pacific Islander Heritage Month, Pride Month and National Coming Out Day, and of course - the story of Havre de Grace and the Upper Chesapeake Bay's impact on Harford County and beyond throughout the ages

Between individual concerts and live performances, monthly and quarterly programs, and weekly foot traffic to our two galleries, we attracted an estimated over 28,000 patrons in 2023.
